What is new about the LEAP this year?



- For the first time, the LEAP will be divided into TWO sections and will be administered at TWO different times:
- Section One = **March 23** (One full day)
 - ELA- Essay
 - Math- 4 constructed response questions
- Section Two = **April 12-16** (One Full Week)
 - All remaining portions of the LEAP Test
 - ELA
 - Math
 - Science
 - Social Studies

- Students will attend LEAP remediation during summer school and will have to re-take the LEAP at the end of the summer.

- Nutrition

- Limited Extracurricular Activities

- Monitor Daily School Performance

How can I monitor my child's daily school performance?
